From the 6 options below, select the activity type you want to create:






Click save. The page will take you to the 'View' tab where you will see a preview of the activity.

Underneath the Check button, click on <> Embed (If the option does not appear, follow the instructions at the end of this document).




Copy the number from the embed URL. This is a unique activity code and will change if the activity is edited and re-saved.







Alternative method for iframe

If '<> embed' does not appear below the activity you can locate the id number by turning on 'Developer mode' in your browser. Select '*Inspect*' as you hover over the 'Check' button. This will help you locate where the .h5p-actions css options are.

Click on the boxes next to 'display' and 'visibility'. The '<> embed' option should now appear below the activity.
